Our new collection of PHAD Paintings of Rajasthan

We have introduced a new collection of PHAD Paintings by the master artisans brother duo from Shahpura, Rajasthan Vijay Joshi & Vivek Joshi.

One of the most ancient arts of India, Phad paintings of the Bhilwara/Shahpura region of Rajasthan can be traced back to more than 700 years. Phad means 'to read' and these paintings are based on songs of legendary Pabuji and Devnarayan that are sung by Bhopa singers. The art known not only for its vibrant colours, but also the fact that it is accompanied by an oral tradition of rendering gatha (folklore). Hand-woven cloth is soaked overnight so that the threads get thicker. It is then starched, burnished for a smooth and shiny surface and then the Phad painter draws the entire narrative on this canvas. The figures are rounded, wear traditional attire and headgear and bright colours are used to fill them in. The colours are painstakingly extracted from natural sources—stones, flowers, herbs The collection can be checked at -

CRAFTS and PRODUCTS EXPANSION

We look forward to expanding our outreach to 10 more crafts this year, expanding from 65+ crafts to 75+ crafts and increasing the impact on livelihoods of 500+ artisans from 400 currently. We will add a few more crafts in metal, grass, pottery and stone crafts.





PROMOTE ECO-FRIENDLY ALTERNATIVES TO PLASTIC

We will work closely with our artisans to offer eco-friendly alternatives to single-use plastics (plates, spoons, straws, forks, etc.) from India's art and craft based sustainable products. We will also run a campaign to have people switch from plastic/artificial rubber yoga mats to grass and natural fibre based yoga mats.





EXPAND THE TEAM


We look to hire a designer, business development executive and project manager to help drive our expansion plans - to increase revenues for our artisans and take up large commissioned projects and develop new products with our artisans

FOCUS ON FUND RAISING ABROAD

This will cover artisans working with wood, spread across 100+ villages.
